Who is this course for?

Institute of the Motor Industry (IMI) Awards limited Apprenticeship in Motorcycle Maintenance and Repair This qualification is both a nationally and internationally recognised award in the motorcycle industry. You will develop both theoretical and practical skills relevant to maintenance and repairs. The course is generally a 2 year programme based upon day release. However, the programme may be modified according to your professional experiences.

Description

Compulsory modules include:

- Contributing to workplace good housekeeping
- Ensuring your own actions reduce risks to Health and Safety
- Maintaining positive working relationships
- Routine motorcycle maintenance
- Remove and replace engine units and components
- Remove and replace electrical auxiliary units and components
- Remove and replace motorcycle chassis units and components

Optional modules include:

- Conduct pre and post work motorcycle inspections
- Remove and replace vehicle transmission and driveline units and components

To gain the apprenticeship you will need to complete the programme. Key Skills may feature as part of the qualification. Dickies Workwear (UK) Ltd sponsors of staff workwear for this course.
