#### Who is this course for?

Successful completion of this apprenticeship will provide students with an IMI Technical Certificate/Diploma, an NVQ Level 3 and integrated practical training and assessment for light vehicle trainees.

Generally a 2 year programme based upon day release. However, the programme may be modified according to your professional experiences.

#### Description

Level 3 compulsory modules:• Remove and replace structural body panels• Repair structural body panels• Rectify vehicle misalignment• Refinish vehicles

Level 3 optional modules:• Create special paint effects

The individual Technical Certificate and NVQ may be studied independently. Functional Skills will feature as part of both apprenticeships.

#### Teaching and Assessment

The IMI course is assessed by online assessments, College-based assignments and short answer tests. The NVQ at Level 2 or 3 will be assessed by demonstration of practical competence in a variety of relevant tasks, a portfolio which will be up to a

national standard plus responses to technical questions to measure your understanding of body repair and refinishing.

Employment as a motor vehicle body repairer and/or vehicle refinishing technician, trainee service receptionist/engineer in vehicle body specialisms or a trainee vehicle body accident repair insurance estimator.
