

Fee Remission for 2013/14 Classroom Based Provision

The College will remit fees for students studying a funded course, who fall within our Funding Council's fee remission policy (this does not include Higher Education or Full Cost courses) *if:-*

- You are aged under 19 on 31/8/13
- You are studying Basic Skills in English or Maths
- You are studying GCSE English/Maths (and do not have grade A-C)
- You are in receipt of Job Seekers Allowance (**not available if you are aged 24+ studying Level 3 or above**)*
- You are in receipt of Employment Support Allowance (WRAG) (**not available if you are aged 24+ studying Level 3 or above**)*
- You are in receipt of Universal Credit (**not available if you are aged 24+ studying Level 3 or above**)*
- You are unemployed, in receipt of a state benefit other than JSA, ESA (WRAG) or Universal Credit and are seeking employment. You must specify the type of benefit you are in receipt of and also confirm that this qualification will help you gain employment (**not available if you are aged 24+ studying Level 3 or above**)
- You are studying Entry Level or Level 1 qualification and are aged 19-23 on the first day of the course and do not have a Full Level 2 qualification and need this to progress to Level 2 or above (**not available for classroom-based ESOL courses**)
- You are studying a Full Level 2 qualification and are aged 19-23 on the first day of the course and do not have a Full Level 2 qualification or above (**not available for classroom-based ESOL courses**)
- You are studying a Full Level 3 qualification and are aged 19-23 on the first day of the course and do not have a Full Level 3 qualification or above
- British Armed Forces only : You are aged 19-23 on the first day of the course and do not have a Full Level 3 qualification and have left the British Armed Forces within the last 10 years. (You must have completed 4 or more years' service or have been discharged due to an injury in active service after completing basic training)
- You are studying a Level 4 qualification or above and are aged 19-23 on the first day of the course and do not have a Full Level 3 qualification or above

**Evidence of JSA, ESA(WRAG) or Universal Credit must be shown at the time of enrolment and be dated within 3 months of the start of the course.*
